Dear Mr. Sartorius:

I write in response to your letter dated January 30, 2012, regarding the East End Eruv Association ("EEEE")'s submission in connection with the placement by EEEA of lechis—i.e., staves—on utility poles located in the right-of-way in the Village of Quogue ("Quogue" or the "Village") for the purpose of establishing an eruv in part of the Village ("Application").

Attached hereto please find exhibits C and D to the contract with LIPA. Also attached please find a letter from LIPA in response to your queries regarding (i) LIPA's approval of the specifications for lechis, (ii) LIPA's approval of attachments to the specific LIPA poles referred to in EEEA's Application, and (iii) LIPA's position regarding LIPA's contract with EEEA.

With respect to your query regarding the poles referred to in Exhibit A to the Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement (Exhibit K to the Application), we believe there is no discrepancy between this list of poles and the list of poles submitted to the Village in the Quogue Eruv Route Chart (Exhibit D to the Application). All of the poles that are individually identified by location and described as being in Quogue on Exhibit A to the Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement are correspondingly listed in the Quogue Eruv Route Chart. The remaining poles identified on the Quogue Eruv Route Chart fall under the general description "Utility Poles running parallel to the train tracks, Quogue/Where South Country Road meets the tracks going East until Scrub Oak Road" in Exhibit A to the Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement. Accordingly, there is no real inconsistency between these pole lists. Further, since the Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement was executed on June 13, 2011, EEEA has conducted another "pole walk" with Verizon, as provided for in Section 19.19 of the Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement, which supersedes the list of poles itemized in Exhibit A to the Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement. Verizon's position with EEEA has been that different "pole walks" are permitted on the strength of the original Verizon Pole Attachment Agreement, and newly executed contracts are not necessary to conduct additional "pole walks." In short, the list of poles submitted as Exhibit D to the Application is the effective list of poles for consideration in the Application.


Finally, with respect to your question regarding an "eruv map," on December 6, 2011, we provided Quogue's counsel with a map approximating what the boundaries of the eruv would be in the event that lechis are attached to the poles in Quogue identified in our Application and in the event that

lechis are attached to certain poles in the Village of Westhampton Beach ("Westhampton Beach"). Pursuant to a December 9, 2011 hearing in the related federal court litigation *East End Eruv Association, Inc., et al. v. Village of Westhampton Beach, et al.*, Case No. 11-0213 (LDW) (E.D.N.Y.), EEEA is separately and concurrently addressing the placement of lechis on utility poles located in Westhampton Beach. Accordingly, the December 6, 2011 map is a representation of where the eruv would be located if lechis are attached to poles in both Quogue and the Westhampton Beach. EEEA has not created a map of an eruv based solely on the poles in Quogue because it seeks to establish an eruv covering areas in both Quogue and Westhampton Beach (which would allow the eruv to include the local synagogue in Westhampton Beach). The Application provides you with a map depicting the location of each utility pole (including the name of the street on which such pole is located) involved in the Application, attached thereto as Exhibit J, which are the only poles that are the subject of this Application.
