

POLITICAL SIGNS IN THE VILLAGE OF QUOGUE

1. **General:** Pursuant to Section 196-44 of the Quogue Village Code, candidate political signs are permitted but only if they meet the size and placement conditions to which other signs not having a political message are subject.
2. **Village Property and Rights of Way:** No signs are permitted on Village property or in the right of way of a public street.
3. **Residence Districts:** In Residence Districts, signs that are permitted include, among others:
 - (a) a sign, not exceeding two square feet, showing the name of the occupant and house number; and
 - (b) a realty sign, not exceeding four square feet, located not more than four feet from the front of a house and at least 25 feet from any lot line.

See Section 196-42 of the Quogue Village Code for further regulations concerning signs in Residence Districts.

4. **Business and Light Industry Districts:** In the Business and Light Industry Districts, signs that are permitted include, among others, free standing signs meeting certain size limits that are located at least 25 feet from any lot line, at least 25 feet from any street and at least 50 feet from any other free standing sign.
