

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF QUOGUE HELD IN THE NORTH MEETING ROOM , 7 VILLAGE LANE, QUOGUE, NEW YORK ON TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2013 AT 11:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Peter Sartorius, Trustees Jeanette Obser, Randy Cardo, and Village Clerk Marcia Rose Koziarz and Carol Moran of The Southampton Press.

ABSENT: Trustees Ted Necarsulmer, Kimberley Payne and Village Attorney Richard E. DePetris.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

The Mayor opened the special meeting, and the 2013-2014 tentative budget was presented to the Board of Trustees. The levy to be raised will increase from last year by approximately 3.5%. Pension expenses, worker's compensation and insurance costs are principal contributing factors. The tax rate is up by 5.4% due to the fact that the net assessment total is down by approximately \$58,000,000.00.

After discussion and with no further business to discuss, and upon motion made by Jeanette Obser, seconded by Randy Cardo and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned at 11:23 P.M.
