The Mayor introduced the proposed Local Law ___ of 2013 “A Local Law Adopting The Provisions Of The Superstorm Sandy Assessment Relief Act” After discussion and upon motion made by Ted Necarsulmer, seconded by Kimberley Payne and unanimously carried, it was established that there was a necessity for immediate passage. Upon motion made by Ted Necarsulmer, seconded by Kimberley Payne and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED, that “Local Law No. ___ of 2013, “A Local Law Adopting The Provisions Of The Superstorm Sandy Assessment Relief Act”, is hereby adopted as Local Law #5 of 2013. Local Law No. 5 of 2013

A Local Law Adopting The Provisions Of The
Superstorm Sandy Assessment Relief Act

Section 1.

It is the intent of this local law to adopt the provisions of the Superstorm Sandy Assessment Relief Act (Chapter 424 of the Laws of 2013 of the State of New York), so that the Village of Quogue will be a participating municipality within the meaning of said Act. Incident to adopting the provisions of said Act, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Quogue does not specifically elect to provide assessment relief as provided in paragraphs (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) of subdivision (a) of section four of said Act, and thus assessment relief as provided in paragraphs (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) of subdivision (a) of section four of said Act (assessment relief for real property that lost less than 50% of its improved value due to Superstorm Sandy) will not be applicable to the Village of Quogue as a participating municipality.

This local law shall become effective upon the filing thereof with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

Upon motion made by Kimberley Payne, seconded by Ted Necarsulmer and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned at 4:10 P.M.
