

2020 Beach Sticker and Locker Applications

The Village Office will begin accepting applications for Village Beach stickers (and lockers) on Friday, May 15th. On that day application forms will be emailed to people receiving this email, and the forms and instructions will be available on the Village website.

Please follow the instructions carefully, sign your application and take care to submit all the information that is required. Only complete applications will be accepted. Incomplete applications will be discarded. Applications can be submitted via mail (preferably), by dropping them off in a marked box in the vestibule of the Village Office, by fax or by e-mail. **The staff will not make copies of car registrations or other documents, and so make sure you get that done in advance.**

Please remember that applications may take up to five business days to process. Beach stickers may be picked up on **Fridays only** between 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.

The Village Office will be open on three Saturdays (June 6th, June 13th and June 20th from 9:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M.) for PICKUP OF BEACH STICKERS. NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE PROCESSED. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT LEAST FIVE (5) BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO EACH OF THOSE SATURDAYS IN ORDER TO BE PICKED UP BY THEN.

2020 is going to be an unusual summer, to say the least, and you may want to bear in mind the following points, which are designed to create a safe environment for users and staff alike, when deciding whether to apply or how many stickers to purchase:

1. We currently expect that the first weekend on which the beach will be staffed is Memorial Day weekend. After that weekend, the beach will be fully staffed on weekends only through June 21, and thereafter will be open all week through Labor Day. Hours of operation will be 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. The parking lot will be closed from 10:00 pm until 10:00 am the following morning.

2. Capacity will be limited whenever the beach is staffed. We anticipate opening only about one-half of the parking spots in the lot. Similar restrictions will be imposed on bikers and walk-ons.
3. The locker rooms and the bathrooms will only be open when the beach is staffed. Being in these areas presents a higher risk of becoming infected than being outside, and so please try to limit your use of them.
4. Use of biker/walk-on passes will be limited to Quogue residents only, and not more than 30 persons will be allowed to enter with these passes.
5. Masks must be worn at all times except when actually in the ocean.
6. Seating on the beach will be limited to specified areas to help assure spacing. When seated or standing with or near someone other than a family member living in the same household, social distancing must be observed.
7. In view of the limited capacity, we hope that people will be considerate of others and voluntarily limit the duration of their stay, but we reserve the right to impose rules that limit the duration of a stay, allow access to some class of stickers (such as odd numbers) only at certain times or on certain days or that are otherwise designed to treat users equitably.
8. There will be no tables or chairs for eating. We anticipate that the food concession will be open starting sometime in June, but food must be consumed on the beach or away from the window.
9. 2020 stickers will not be required until June 20th. However, commencing on Memorial Day weekend, access will be limited to Quogue residents or renters, and you will have to display either a 2019 sticker or other evidence of residency, such as a utility bill showing a physical address in Quogue or a copy of a valid lease.
10. We reserve the right to amend or modify these rules at any time without notice.
11. Sanctions for failure to follow the rules will be severe. After one warning, a second infraction will result in a seven-day suspension of beach privileges. A third infraction will result in revocation of beach privileges for the season. In addition, a willful failure to follow a direction of a lifeguard or other beach staff member, code enforcement officer or police officer will result in immediate revocation of beach privileges for the season.
12. Parents will bear responsibility for the behavior of their children under age 16.
13. Your purchase of a beach sticker or use of the Village Beach will constitute your acceptance of the foregoing rules as they may be amended or modified from time to time.
